The Scholarships are available towards tuition fees of up to 30% (Thirty Percent) for PhD/DBA degrees commencing in 2019 and only available to eligible Zambians. All PhD/DBA students under the Scholarship are expected to work with Full-Time Faculty as Tutors and Teaching Assistants when they have the demonstrable skills and knowledge of their research areas. Students will be supervised by a cohort of renowned international and local Scholars and experts.

 - I. Research Title;
 - II. Subject area;
 - III. Abstract;
 - IV. Introduction/Background;
 - V. Statement of the Problem;
 - VI. Research Objectives;
 - VII. Research Questions or hypotheses; and
 - VII. Rationale/Justification of Research Topic
- 2. Certified copy of transcripts of results;
- 3. Bachelors and Masters Degrees Certificates;
- 4. Enclose two(2) reference letters from your referees (one academic and one professional);
- 5. Attach two passport size photos;
- 6. Curriculum vitae;
- 7. Application form which can be obtained from the University of Lusaka website: www.unilus.ac.zm;
- 8. Payment of a non-refundable fee of ZMK 150 for the application form; and
- 9. A cover letter.
